Survey of Screw Shaft M. V. "DUVALLA".

With reference to your letter of the 13th ultimo, asking us to arrange for a Chief Engineer, from one of the steamers, to come ashore and survey the Screw Shaft of the M. V. "Duvalla". Up to the time of writing it has not been possible to obtain the services of a Chief Engineer. In the meantime the writer has seen Mr. A. D. Barclay ( Firestone Plantations Co., ) the ship's late Captian who has informed us that it will be impossible to survey the Screw Shaft without the vessel goes into dry dock. It was at first thought possible to beach the vessel and then complete the survey, but owing to the rise of the river being exceptionally small, this is not possible, and if the vessell was beached, it would be impossible to float her again.

In view of the above, will you please revise your instructions and inform us accordingly.
