Some indented plating requires to be dealt with at the first convenient opportunity.

The Genoa Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, the S.S. No. 1, due 3.26, which was partly held at Leghorn, completed, and the bottom coated.

The steam turbines and boilers have been removed and Diesel engines fitted, bunkers and seatings altered to suit same, ceiling fitted in the holds in way of the DB tanks which are now used for carrying oil fuel & the centre keelson in these tanks made reasonably tight.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, with record of survey 2.28 and notation of S.S. No. 1-28, subject to the indented plating on starboard side forward being dealt with at the Owners' convenience. *as recommended.*
