With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "DUCE", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had under consideration your letter of the 2nd instant, addressed to the Society's Genoa Surveyors, from which it is noted that, with a view to economy, you have reluctantly been compelled to allow the vessel's class with this Society to lapse.

In the circumstances, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of the Steamer's class, the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.

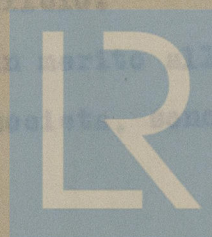
