Referring to my report no 2702 on  
the S.S. "Mauriso," I beg leave to inform you  
that the safety valves of the main boilers  
were adjusted by me under steam to 185 lbs  
per sq. inch, the working pressure being 180 lbs. The  
safety valves are fitted with easing gear, & the  
smallest distance of boilers or uptakes & bunkers or  
woodwork is 18 inches. I regret that these  
particulars were inadvertently omitted from  
my report.
