They further add that their decision regarding the discontinuance of Lloyd's Classification is not the result of any unpleasant cooperation, on the contrary their relations with this Society have been of the most agreeable nature.

It is submitted the class of the vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book, and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
