The Second Special Survey No.2 became due in April last, and in November last the Classing Committee had before them a request from the Owners' Superintendent for permission to commence the Special Survey in April, 1930, and to complete the same in April, 1931, with a view to bringing into line the surveys due under the Society's Rules and those requiring to be held for the Registro Italiano. It was explained to the Owners'

Superintendent that this would mean the granting of two years of grace and that the request could not be acceded to, and it was suggested to him that arrangements might be made with the Registro Italiano for the survey on behalf of that Society to be anticipated.

In a letter, dated 10th instant, however, the Owners write that they desire the steamer's class to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book, and state that she will continue to be classed with the Registro Italiano.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Tuesday, 21st instant, and decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
