Nature of Survey

When due

The 2nd S.S.No.2 became due 4,29, and a proposal to carry out same within the year of grace has been agreed to.

Some damage to shell plating requires to be repaired at the first favourable opportunity. The shell plating requires to be drilled (vessel over 24 years old).

An application from the Owners' Representative to commence the 2nd S.S.No.2 in April 1930, and to complete same in April 1931 received consideration on the 5th November, when he was informed that


"as the special survey in question became due under the Society's Rules eight years from the previous special survey No.3, viz:- in April 1929, they (the Committee) regret they cannot agree to the completion of the inspection remaining over until April 1931".

"If the Committee met the Owners' wishes in this matter, you will see that it would virtually be granting two years of grace in which to complete the survey, and you will I am sure understand that this cannot be done, consistently with the Society's Rules on the subject, which only provide for one year of grace".

"The Committee quite appreciate the Owners' desire seeing that the vessel holds the classification both of the Registro Italiano and this Society that the surveys of both Institutions should run concurrently, and they suggest that this might be readily arranged by the Registro Italiano special survey being anticipated when the special survey No.2 required by the Society's Rules is carried out, especially having regard to the fact that the Committee note from your letter that the Owners are prepared to carry out the second special survey No.3 when it falls due in April, 1933."

A letter has now been received from the Owners reading as follows:-

"We hereby beg to give notice that we desire that the above steamer's class should be withdrawn from your Register Book and signified as withdrawn at the Owners request. The vessel will continue to be classed in the Registro Italiano".
