I have to inform you that Messrs. Scheepswerf "Gideon" (J.H.Koster Hzn, Groningen) are going to build a sister vessel of the motorship yard number 154 ("ROBRIX") built by them under special survey, to the Society's class under yard number 164, and in order to save delay I have arranged with the Builders and the Amsterdam Surveyors, who are in possession of the approved plans of the m.s. 154, to note on these plans: sister vessel 164 and I shall be pleased if you will do the same in the London Office.
