Mr. Harvey, Chief Superintendent of Messrs. Furness Withy & Co., Ltd., called at this Office and stated that the spare parts of the compressor for this ship had been built by Messrs. Deutsche Werke, Kiel, and that on examination at Glasgow, it was found that there were some blow holes in one of the castings, which he stated the Society's Surveyors would not approve except under certain conditions.

Messrs. Deutsche Werke, Kiel in a letter to Mr. Harvey stated that they had seen these blow holes and had dealt with them, and the compressor casing in question had been surveyed by the Society's Surveyors and had been taken over without objection.

IT IS SUBMITTED that a wire should be sent to Mr. Campbell, Senior Engineer Surveyer at Glasgow, who should be requested to reply by return <sup>of post</sup> stating how the matter stands.
