S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "KOTSU MARU", I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe have forwarded to this Office your letter dated 23rd April last, addressed to them, from which it is noted that, on account of her age, it is not your intention to retain her classification with this Society.

In the circumstances the Committee, who have had the case before them at their meeting today, have given instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I may add that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe have also forwarded to this Office the Freeboard Certificate which accompanied your letter to them, and the same has been duly cancelled.
