Lagos. Our record for this vessel is :- Built March, 1908.
Survey held - No.3. Feb. 1922. 2nd No.1. 1924. Now due for
Second No.2. Survey.

You will see from this that the No.3. Survey was
held in February, 1922, and the Second No.1. in 1924, but we
think this must be a mistake as, of course, she would go four
years from the No.3. Survey, which would make her due for
Second No.1. in 1926, and Second No.2. in 1930.

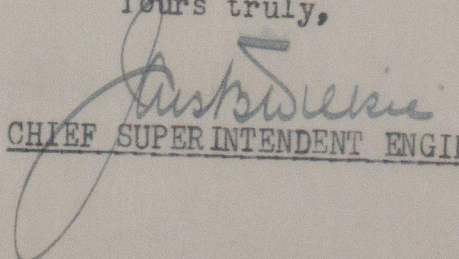

In any case, it is not our intention to put this vessel through her Second No.2. Survey, but we wish to know when it is actually due as we do not wish to withdraw her from Class until Lloyd's Certificate actually expires, as, when this Certificate expires it will be necessary for us to apply to the Marine Department of the Nigerian Government for a Loadline Certificate for this vessel.
