
Dear Sir,

I enclose herewith a copy of a letter, dated 10th ultimo, which has been received from Mr. George Wilson respecting the s.s. "ILORIN". Mr. Wilson, as you may be aware carries out surveys on behalf of the Society at Lagos when necessity arises, and in connexion with this particular case, I think it well to say that there is no record in this Office that any part of the Second Special Survey No.2 on the hull of this vessel has been carried out and in view of the statement in Mr. Wilson's letter I shall be glad if you will make the position clear to Mr. Wilkie, Superintendent Engineer of Messrs. Elder, Dempster & Co., at your port.
