The letter returning this undertaking was dated 5th May, 1932, and was signed by Mr. Claude Angel, a Director of the Henley Steamship Company Ltd., who also signed the undertaking.

In view of the circumstances, as explained in my letter of the 31st ultimo, the Committee, who have had the case again under consideration today, regret they have had no alternative but to give instructions for this vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
