due for her annual boiler survey. Also, I believe, she has
been re-measured for freeboard purposes under the New Convention
It would be of great assistance to the new Owners if you
could be good enough to allow this steamer to trade for say
two weeks with a view of working her round to this channel, and
enable the boiler survey to be done here together with the
line marking, meantime giving the new Owners a temporary
certificate.

For your guidance immediate steps are being taken with
a view of carrying out the Special Survey of the "EMSWORTH MANOR"
it is hoped to complete in the very near future, as well
as "CHISWICK MANOR" and "ACTON MANOR".
