I called at the National Provincial Bank with
regard to the S.S."EMSWORTH MANOR" and informed the
representative that the Henley S.S.Co. state they cannot
give the usual undertaking required in cases of laid up
vessels.

I was informed that quite recently the Bank
appointed Mr.W.A.Green, of Cymric Buildings, Cardiff Docks,
as Ships' Manager for the four vessels, and that that gentleman
has full power to sign the form of undertaking.

It was suggested that the Cardiff Surveyors should
call upon that gentleman and inform him that in order that
the vessel's class may remain undisturbed in the Register
Book it is necessary for this undertaking to be given. With
this explanation the Bank feel sure Mr.Green will comply
with our request.
