With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo and to previous correspondence respecting the overdue Special Survey No.3 of your steamer "CHISWICK MANOR", I have to inform you I am now in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Cardiff in reference to the survey held by them on this vessel in February, 1931, and in view of what they report the Committee will be prepared to accept the examination of the bottom and rudder, the steering chains and fairleads, the chain cables and the windlass as part of the Special Survey in question.

As regards the machinery, the following will also be accepted :- Examination of the sea connections, the crank, thrust and tunnel shafting, and the circulating pump.


I shall be glad to learn in due course what steps you now propose to take to complete the survey.
