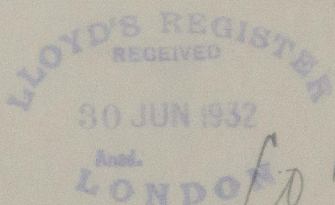

With reference to the enquiry contained in the Classing letter of the 28th instant regarding the steamer "CHISWICK MANOR", I beg to advise you that in my opinion the examination of the bottom and rudder, the steering chains and fairleads, the chain cables, and the windlass, might be accepted as part Special Survey No.3.

As regards machinery, it is considered that the examination of the sea connections, the crank, thrust and tunnel shafting, and the circulating pump, might also be accepted as part *L.M.C. M.S. for Special Survey No.3.
