Dear Sirs,


I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 27th instant, having further reference to the case of your steamer "CHISWICK MANOR", and the Committee desire me to again say that for the reasons previously mentioned in my letter of the 24th instant, they do not see how they can possibly agree to the postponement you desire before completing the overdue Special Survey No.5, but as regards the point you raise in reference to the survey held at Cardiff in January/February 1931, the matter will be looked into, and after I have communicated with the Surveyors at that port, I will write you further in due course, as to what part of this survey can be accepted as complying with the requirements of the Special Survey No.5.
