We beg to acknowledge receipt of your favour of 24th instant re the above steamer, and very much regret that your Committee are not disposed to assist us in any way to run this vessel in order that we may put ourselves in funds to carry out the necessary work required for Survey.

It is quite true, the year of grace expired in April last, but against this we would again mention that the steamer has been laid up during the whole of year of grace, so there has been absolutely no wear and tear. We previously mentioned the fact that this steamer underwent extensive repairs in January/February 1931, prior to laying up. A good deal of the work then completed would have counted as part of the Survey. In your letter you do not refer to this point in any way, and before ~~you~~^{we} come to a decision as to what we should do we shall be glad to learn if your Committee are agreeable to count the work done in Drydock under your Surveyors as being part of the requirements of the Survey.
