
Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 20th instant relative to your steamer "CHISWICK MANOR", which vessel has been laid up for some time past at Cardiff and regarding which you furnished, on the 5th ultimo, the undertaking required by the Committee in connexion with the completion of the overdue Special Survey No.3.

The Committee have had your letter under consideration at their meeting today and desire me to point out that, as the year of grace allowed for the completion of this Special Survey expired last April, they regret that they are unable to accede to your request to postpone carrying out the survey for a further twelve months, or even six months, if the vessel is to go into commission.

I have at the same time to refer you to the terms of the printed letter of undertaking, upon which, up to the present, the vessel has been allowed to retain her class, namely: that the requirements of the Special Survey would be carried out before this vessel leaves Cardiff, and that "in the event of her going to sea without complying with these conditions her class shall be automatically cancelled".

I trust, therefore, you will be able to make
