# Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

Dear Sirs,

S. I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Marseilles have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 24th ultimo addressed to them respecting the steamer "KROUMIR", from which it is noted that you no longer desire to retain the vessel's classification in the Society's Register Book.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, and in the circumstances instructions have been given for the vessel's class to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
