Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 20th instant, respecting the ex-German steamer "IZMIR", I have to inform you that your remarks have been carefully noted; and that the scantlings of the vessel as lifted from the ship and indicated on the plans forwarded (but which are not guaranteed) are such as to entitle the vessel to load to the full Table A draught corresponding to a freeboard of $3'-6\frac{1}{2}"$ measured from the statutory deck line $1\frac{1}{2}"$ above steel deck at side.

It is, however, not considered advisable to assign a preliminary freeboard until the vessel comes under survey for classification with this Society, when the actual scantlings could be ascertained by the Surveyors.

The plans are returned herewith.
