Nature of Survey When due

The 2nd S.S. No.2 became due 6,33 and a proposal to postpone same has been agreed to subject to the survey being completed before the expiration of the year of grace.

On the 1st instant the Boulogne Surveyor wrote that the vessel was on the floating dock at his port undergoing repairs, but that he had not been asked to carry out any survey.

In reply to enquiry the Owners now write that <sup>to and their</sup> "for personal reasons") they do not wish to continue the classification of this vessel in Lloyd's Register.

It is submitted the class of this vessel be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.
