Dear Sirs,

With reference to the Classification in the Society's Register Book of the steam single screw tug "SWAN", built by Messrs. George Brown & Co., at Greenock in May 1927, I have to point out that this vessel's screw shaft became due for inspection at the end of May last, but no action has yet been taken in the matter as there is no information in this Office regarding the Ownership of this tug.

From the First Entry Report it would appear that the vessel was built to the order of Messrs. McKie & Baxter of Glasgow, the makers of the engines and that she was intended for clients in the Malay Peninsula. Upon completion she was put on board the motorship "DOLIUUS" at Glasgow for shipment for Port Swettenham.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will make enquiries and let me know the name and address of the Owners, and at the same time ascertain what arrangements are proposed to be made with a view to the screwshaft being drawn for inspection.
