
S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "VENI", I beg to acquaint you that when the Third Special Survey No. 1 of this vessel was partly held at Bergen in May last year, the Society's Surveyor at that port recommended that this inspection should be completed, and the necessary repairs effected, by the end of April 1930, when the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules would expire.

This recommendation, however, has not been carried into effect, and the Society's Bergen Surveyor states that the repairs considered requisite are not being carried out, and in these circumstances, the Committee have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
