I am in receipt of your letter of the 25th instant enclosing a plan in triplicate showing an amended proposal in respect of the steel hatch covers proposed for the Burntisland Shipbuilding Co.'s Yard No. 235, and I note your remarks.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith and I have pleasure in stating that the scantlings and arrangements as shown and amended will be approved provided they be carried out to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.

As suggested, the thickness of the plating of No. 3 cover at No. 2 hatch could be .28" but No. 4 cover should be .30" as amended.

One copy of the plan is being retained for record and the remaining copy is being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Leith for their information.

It is observed that two copies of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 16th instant, were returned to you with mine of the 24th, and I shall be much obliged if you will be so good as to forward a copy of this plan to the Society's Surveyors at Leith for their information.
