Dear Sir,

I beg to state that in Messrs. Ned. Dok My's Yard no. 69 and Messrs. N.V.C.v.d. Giessen & Zonen's Yard no. 653 longitudinal bottom frames are fitted [12" x 3½" x .50/.60 and not [300 x 100 x 10/16 mm. as indicated on the approved midship section.

Messrs. Ned. Dok My state that the section [12" x 3½" x .54/.60" has been originally approved by you, but as they could not obtain this profile they proposed the section [300 x 100 x 10/16 mm. which you approved with the notation "Owners' consent to be obtained to this thickness".

The Owners, however, did not agree to the [300 x 100 x 10/16 mm. and consequently the builders ordered [12" x 3½" x .50/.60" for this purpose.

In connexion therewith I shall be glad to know if this is correct and if this section, viz. [12" x 3½" x .50/.60 for the longitudinal bottom frames can be approved.

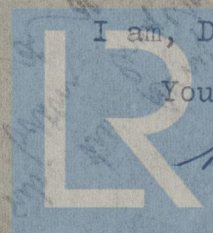
