Dear Sirs,

M. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th ultimo enclosing five plans (in duplicate) of Schat Davits, type PHA for Messrs. Giessen & Zonen's Yard No. 653, Nederlandsche Dok No. 69, Werf Gusto No, 726, and Odense Staalskibsvaerft No. 71, and with regard thereto I have to inform you that provided the davits be constructed as shown and to your satisfaction, they will be approved for the maximum load and outreach indicated on the plans.

The steel to be used in the construction of the davits must be made by the Open Hearth process at works recognised by the Committee, and must be tested in accordance with the requirements of the Rules.

It will be necessary for you to satisfy yourselves that the workmanship is sound and to pay special attention to the electric welding of the davits. The Rules for the Application of Electric Arc Welding to Ship Construction should be complied with, and electrodes complying with paras. 1-9, Section 4 of these Rules should be used.
