THE WAR
CABO S. VICENTE.—Lisbon, Mar. 11.—An unknown plane sank the Portuguese trawler Cabo S. Vicente, 103 tons (net), which was fishing off the beach of Ericeira last night. Another trawler, the Amor, managed to save the crew. Survivors, who were landed at Lisbon this afternoon, declared that the plane machine-gunned the vessel when 23 miles off Ericeira. The crew took to the lifeboat and the plane then sank the trawler with bombs.—Reuter.
