I may add that this is a sister vessel to the S.S. "COULMORE", in which case the construction also was commenced in 1929.

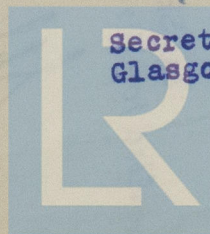
