CLIFTONHALL. — (Lancaster) Marques. June 21. — The crew of the British motor vessel Cliftonhall, who have arrived here, describe how she was sunk 46 miles off Anglesey, 100 miles south-west of Mozambique, 11 days ago, on her way to Cape Town from the north. She sunk in 12 mins. after being torpedoed. All the crew escaped, the 16th of whom were taken by the British. — Reuter.
