Dear Sirs,

S. I am favoured with your letter of the 9th instant relative to the Screwshaft Survey of the Motorship "CLIFTONHALL" and have placed the case before the Committee at their meeting today.

The Committee have carefully noted your remarks but I am directed to point out that while they will not insist upon the screwshaft being drawn when the vessel is docked at Talcahuano they consider that the opportunity should be taken for the propeller to be removed and the shaft cone inspected. Should the shaft cone be found satisfactory and the wear down of the shaft not excessive it will then be in order for the Screwshaft Survey to be postponed for a further period.

I shall be obliged if you will kindly endeavour to make the necessary arrangements and perhaps you will be good enough to advise me in due course of what is being done in this connection.
