I duly received Mr. Bartlett's letter of the 24th instant enclosing one from Messrs. Wm. Doxford & Sons, Ltd., together with a plan, in duplicate, of section through midship deckhouse for their Yard No. 642, and their remarks have been noted.

One copy of the plan is returned herewith and I have to state that the scantlings and arrangements as shewn will be approved, provided they be carried out to your satisfaction.

With the arrangements proposed at the ship's sides, as shewn in detail on the plan, the two webs previously required to be fitted to the deckhouse sides may be omitted.

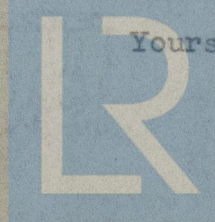
The proposal to fit well hollowed out brackets to the house front stiffeners will also be approved, provided the brackets be of suitable thickness.
