M. I return herewith one copy of each of the plans, forwarded with Mr. Bartlett's letter of the 10th instant, of midship section, profile and decks of the Single Screw Steamer No. 642 proposed to be built by Messrs. Wm. Doxford & Sons, Ltd., for the West Hartlepool Steam Navigation Co., and with regard thereto I have to state that provided the scantlings and arrangements as shewn and amended be adhered to, the Rules in all other respects be complied with, and the materials and workmanship be to the Society's satisfaction, the vessel will be eligible to be classed 100A1 with a freeboard corresponding to a draught not exceeding that contemplated by the Rules for a complete superstructure vessel having a tonnage opening.

The points in regard to the Rule length as given in Mr. Bartlett's letter have been duly noted.

The duplicate plans are being retained for record.
