Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of the steamer "MONTROYAL", which vessel it is understood has now become your property, I beg to acquaint you that the Second Special Survey No. 2 became due on this vessel in August, 1928, but has not been completed.

The Committee have hitherto deferred action in regard to the steamer's class whilst she was laid up on the understanding that the survey would be completed before she proceeded to sea, but as it now appears that the vessel has proceeded from Southend for Stavanger to be broken up and the remaining requirements of the survey have not been complied with, the Committee have had no alternative but to give instructions for the class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught will all be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby


