Dear Sir,

In reference to your letters of 26th inst. regarding the First Entry Report on the s.s. " PRIMULA " we have to say that the floors, attachments and intermediate brackets at centre line in double bottom, transverses in machinery space and forward & deck longitudinals at ends are as approved, and the spacing of the rivets in the raised quarter deck side plating butts is as required . -

The number of webs to each hatch is as follows : -  
N° 1 Hatch = 3 webs. Nos. 2, 3 and 4 = 5 webs . -

We regret that this was not clearly stated in the first place and we have noted that in future similar cases the scantlings of tranverses and deck longitudinals at ends should be reported . -


