Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the fishing vessel "PONTUL EUXIN" I beg to remind you that a notice in regard to the Special Survey No.1, which became due at the end of June 1929, was sent to you from this Office on the 15th July, 1929 and that no reply has been received to this communication.

The Society's Surveyor at Braila also states that he has written to you on several occasions, but has received no answer to his letters.

The Committee had the case before them at their meeting to-day and they desire me to inform you that as the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the survey expired at the end of last month, arrangements must be made for the requisite inspection to take place forthwith in order to entitle the vessel to retain her class.

I shall, therefore, be glad to learn by return mail, for the information of the Committee, what steps you propose taking in the matter.
