Plans and particulars of scantlings were examined in this Office and the Surveyors were informed that provided the usual conditions were complied with and a favourable report be received, the vessel could be recommended for the class 100 A.- For Fishing Purposes.

The Boulogne Surveyor now forwards a report giving particulars of scantlings and further reports the vessel placed in dry dock and the requirements of a special survey^{N° 3} carried out.

The wood deck has been renewed and minor repairs effected.

No certificates have been produced for the equipment.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be classed 100 A.- "For Fishing Purposes" with record of survey 6-25 Bou. and Notation of s.s. Bou. No. 3-6-25.
