With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "MEIKO MAR" I beg to acquaint you that I am now in receipt of a report from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe from which it appears that the vessel has been examined by them afloat and the Special Survey No.3 advanced. The Surveyors recommend that certain parts of the vessel which are badly corroded and wasted be scaled so that a thorough examination can be made.

At the same time the Kobe Surveyors have forwarded to this Office your letter of the 24th ultimo, addressed to them, from which it is noted that it is your desire that the class of this vessel in the Society's Register Book be cancelled for the time being.

The case has received the consideration of the Committee at their Meeting today and I am directed to inform you that, in view of your intimation and of the condition of the vessel, they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from

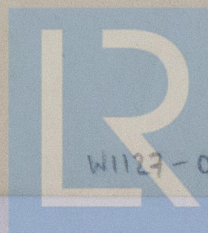
