

The fee for Reclassification Survey on the Hull, assuming the Survey to be carried out entirely in this country, is £57. 10s. and of this amount, £27. was charged for work done in this country and £17. 10s. for work done at New York.

The vessel has been lost through enemy action.

The reports have been examined and having regard to the proportion of the Survey held it is submitted, that as the fees already charged cover the work done, no further fee be charged.
