"EMPIRE STAR", 12656 tons gross of Belfast, on the 15th September, 1942 & subsequently as she lay at Liverpool and Birkenhead, for the purpose of fitting shelter tween deck bulkheads in accordance with Ministry of War Transport Circulars M/152376/42 and M.S. 603/42.

Now Done:- New Bulkhead erected on S.S. on frame No.8.  
Opening in Bulkhead on Frame No.16 on P.S. permanently plated up and Bulkhead reinforced as necessary.  
New Bulkheads erected P. & S. at aft end of Motor casing on Frame No.27 and between Nos.4 & 5 Holds on Frame No.53.  
Existing Bulkhead between Nos.5 & 6 Holds on Frame No.68 reinforced as necessary and openings permanently plated up.

On completion of alterations Bulkheads satisfactorily tested.  
To complete the requirements scuppers require to fitted from all intact tween deck spaces.
