With reference to Mr Hill's classing letter of date the 9<sup>th</sup> instant, regarding the s/s "PORTMEOR" No 3267, I beg to state that sheerstrake and R.Q. Deck side plating are increased at the break as required, the rivets of the seams, and butts of the bridge, and fore-castle side plating are as required, the butts of sheerstrake treble riveted, the thickness of stiffeners on the after peak bulkhead 3/4 as required, the stream, and tow line, steel wire, tested as required, in this and the sister vessel "GOWERAIN". a hand pump is fitted to the fore peak flat and in good working order, the butts of plating &c are properly shifted and strapped, and the erections the same as in the sister vessel.
