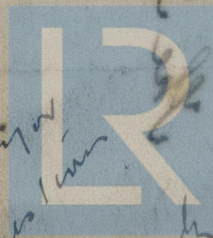
It is submitted the Surveyor be informed that in cases similar to this where the lower steel have ^{assigned} ~~been~~ ^{to} later date of build than that provided for in the rules ^{by} ~~in~~ ^{months} ~~after~~ ^{date} of launch, the builders have taken special measures to preserve the structure from corrosion by coating internally with paint & by placing the vessel in dry dock for ~~electrolytic~~ ^{recoating} of the bottom.
