S. With reference to Newport News Report No.5290 and Baltimore Report No.7159 of Classification Survey held on the steamer "WEST KEDRON" now named "EMPIRE ELAND", I have to acquaint you that an inclusive fee of £275 (£175 for hull and £100 for machinery), has now been charged to the Managers and I shall be glad if you will arrange for this amount to be suitably apportioned as between the Baltimore and Newport News Offices, bearing in mind that fifteen visits were paid by Mr. Hudson for the hull and three by Mr. Buchanan and that the whole of the machinery was done by Mr. Hudson.
