S. With reference to the case of the steamer "EMPIRE ELAND" ex "WEST KEDRON", I beg to acquaint you that the reports of the survey held on this vessel at Baltimore have now come to hand from which it appears that the survey for classification was completed at that port.

In the circumstances the vessel has been assigned a class of 100A1 fitted for Oil Fuel 1920 P.P. above 150° F. together with notations of S.S. N.Ns. No.3-8,40; LMC 8,40; T.S. (c.l.) 6,40.

An inclusive fee of £275 is due for the Classification Survey of this vessel and I accordingly forward herewith an account for this amount. |||

It is understood the vessel is now under the inspection of the Society's Surveyors at Hull for permanent repairs recommended by the Liverpool Surveyors to be effected to No.2 hatch coaming, deck plating, bulwarks, hatch covers, etc.
