The class is subject to the rudder stock being specially examined (for twist) at the next dry docking (Off. Rpt. 53985) and two indented shell plates No.3 in the 3rd strake and No.4 in the 4th strake below sheer being permanently repaired at the Owners' convenience (N.Yk. Rpt. 41384).

The NEWPORT MON. Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

The outstanding items, as above, continue efficient.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of docking survey 6.42 subject as above.
