COPY OF OFFICIAL LOG BOOK ENTRY OF S/S "EOCENE" WITH REFERENCE TO HER
TOUCHING BOTTOM A A PASSAGE FROM HAIFA TO ALEXANDRIA.

19th. April 1942. Approximate position - Lat. 31 - 22 N Long. 33 - 08 E.

Whilst on passage from Haifa to Alexandria at 1226 hours on the 19th. April, 1942 and in a position approximately 8 to 10 miles northwards of Kas Burun vessel touched bottom lightly. Wheel was immediately put hard at starboard and engines were kept at full ahead. Vessel swung clear in to deeper water and proceeded without further incident. A cast of the lead taken at 1230 gave $6\frac{1}{2}$ fathoms. All wells sounded and found dry.
