Dear Sir,

I shall be glad if you ascertain from the Owners of the steamer "POWEY ROSE", and let me know, what arrangements they propose making to carry out a survey for the renewal of the Freeboard Certificate which expires on the 11th July next.


I think it well to add that to complete the 2nd Special Survey No.1, the anchors and cables, chain locker and engine and boiler spaces require to be examined and, as regards the machinery, the cylinders, pistons, slide valves, main engine driven pumps, condenser and pumping arrangements require to be examined and the steam pipes examined and tested. Some worn frames and beams also require to be dealt with.

In the circumstances, I shall be glad to learn whether the Owners anticipate being able to complete this inspection without causing delay to the vessel. If not a General Examination of the outstanding items will require to be held before the end of July next and it is concluded that the survey decided upon for maintenance of class will receive attention in conjunction with the Freeboard Survey.
