Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 6th instant, enclosing the draft contract for the building of the steamer "CORNISH MERCHANT", together with a statement of the payments made by the Cornish Traders, Ltd. for this vessel, I think it well to point out that it would be to the benefit of the creditors generally if you paid the fees for the survey for classification of the "CORNISH MERCHANT", which, as you are aware, amount to £88:7:8, as, in return, the classification certificates could be placed in your hands. This, I may suggest, might enable you to enforce payment from the Cornish Traders, Ltd., of the balance of £114:1:5 due from them.

I return the above mentioned documents and shall be glad to hear from you again on this subject in due course.
