We have your letter of yesterday with enclosures. It is difficult to understand why the Cornish Traders Ltd. paid the full purchase price of the vessel without insisting upon delivery of Classification Certificate in accordance with the terms of the contract; as they have done so, it seems to us that it is not open to them to complain at being asked to pay the fees themselves. However, we note that it has been decided not to press them further.

We think it would be worth while to ask the Liquidator to produce for inspection the contract for building the "Cornish Merchant" and the account showing the payments made under this contract. It is possible that the information so obtained might enable you to put forward a claim for payment of the fees in full.
